As featured in our Fortnightly Foodies activity every second Wednesday at 11am, give this delicious **Gooey Rasberry Spoon Cake Recipe** a try.

Ingredients

2 cups frozen raspberries

1/3 cup raspberry jam

2 cups SR flour

2/3 cup caster sugar

200g butter, melted/cooled

1 cup milk

1 egg, lightly beaten

180g block white chocolate, broken into pieces

STEP 1

Preheat oven to 180C or 160 fan-forced, grease a 5cm deep, 21cm x 29cm ovenproof dish STEP 2

Place raspberries and jam in a microwave-safe bowl. Microwave on HIGH for 1 min or until raspberries soften slightly. Using a fork, mash raspberry mixture until pulpy, keeping some raspberries whole. STEP 3

Combine flour and sugar in a large bowl, make a well. Add butter, milk and egg, mix well to combine. Fold in white chocolate. Spoon mixture into prepared dish.

Level with a spatula Drizzle with ¾ of the raspberry sauce STEP 4

Bake for 40 to 45 mins or until top is golden and firm to touch. Stand for 10 mins, drizzle with remaining raspberry mixture. Top with vanilla ice-cream and dust with icing sugar.


